## iOS Quick Start Guide

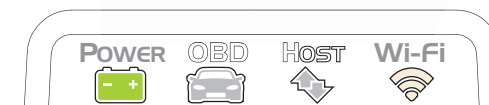
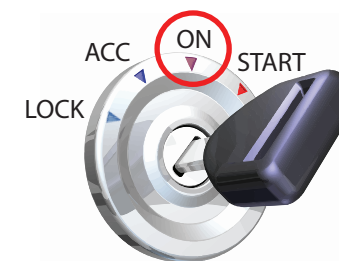


### 2 Download & install OBDLink app

Scan the QR code or visit the URL from your iOS device to download the OBDLink app:



### 4 Turn ignition to Key On, Engine Off position



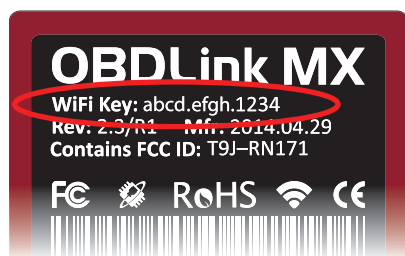
Vehicles with push button start: press the button without stepping on the brake pedal.

'POWER' LED will turn ON, and the white 'Wi-Fi' LED will emit a flash every 3 seconds.

– LEDs are off? Check vehicle for blown fuses.

### 1 Write down the 14-digit Wi-Fi Key

The factory default Wi-Fi Key is found on the bottom of the unit. It is **lowercase** and includes periods.

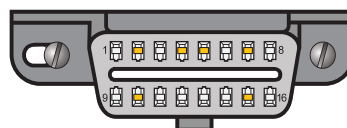

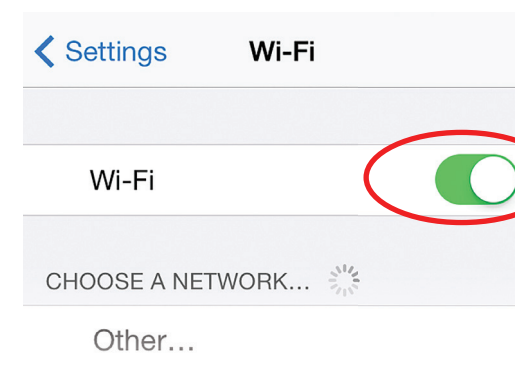
### 3 Plug MX Wi-Fi into the diagnostic link connector (DLC)

The DLC is usually found on the driver's side, under the dash.

### 5 Open 'Settings' app, and enable Wi-Fi

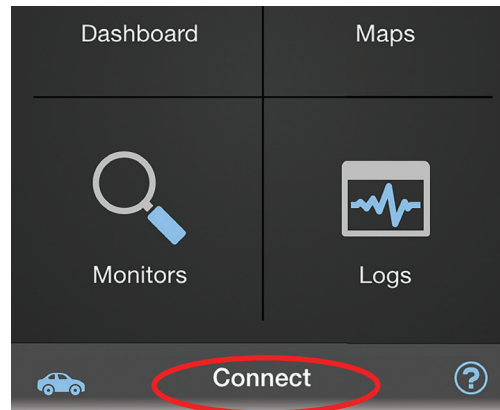

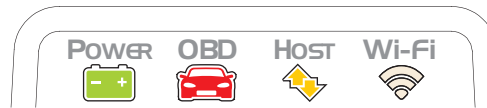
## 6 Select 'OBDLink MX' from the network list



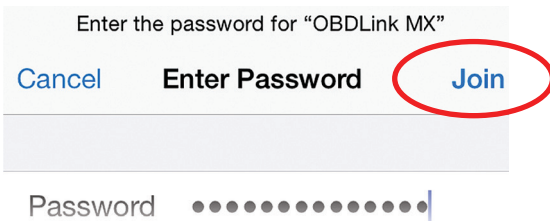
## 8 Launch the OBDLink app, and tap 'Connect'



Once the connection is established, the 'Wi-Fi' LED will turn on solid. Tap 'Diagnostics' to start a scan.

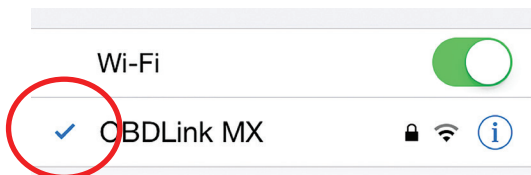


## 7 Enter the Wi-Fi Key from step #1 in the 'Password' field, and tap 'Join'



*- Remember that the Password is lowercase and includes periods.*

A checkmark next to 'OBDLink MX' indicates a successful connection.



The 'Wi-Fi' LED will change to a slow blink.
