

Creating a communication log

Step 1- Identify the COM port number

If you already know the COM port your scan tool is connected to, please skip to step 2.

- a) Run the **STN Finder** utility from the installation CD. *If you no longer have the CD, download STN Finder from the ScanTool.net website (Downloads->Utilities).*
- b) Make sure the scan tool is connected to the vehicle and the computer
- c) Click the **Start** button. Make note of the **COM port** number and the **baud rate** where the scan tool was found. If the scan tool wasn't found, disconnect and reconnect all cables, and click the Start button again.

Step 2- Collecting data

- a) Run **STN Term** from the installation CD. *If you don't have the CD, download STN Term from the ScanTool.net website (Downloads->Utilities).*
- b) Set the **COM port** number and the **baud rate** (which you found in step 1).
- c) Enter the following commands, making sure to wait for the prompt (">") character before sending the next command:

```
ATZ
ATI
STI
AT@1
AT@2
ATRV
ATDP
ATSP 00
0100
ATDP
```

```
ATSP 1
0100
ATSP 2
0100
ATSP 3
0100
ATSP 4
0100
ATSP 5
0100
ATSP 6
0100
ATSP 7
0100
ATSP 00
```

- d) Right click in the terminal window, and click **Select All**.
- e) Right click on the selected text, and click **Copy**.
- f) Create a new forum post, then right click in the post editor, and click **Paste**.
